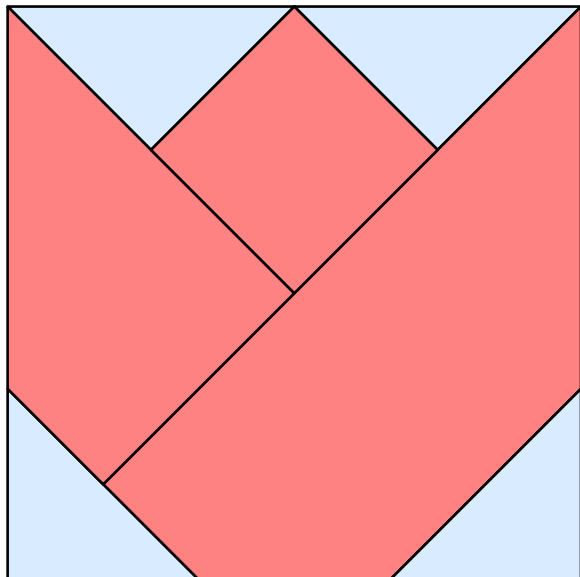


# FUN WITH FOUNDATION PAPER PIECING

## TULIP



### STEP 1 - PRINT THE PIECING PATTERN

If making just one 3 inch block, print pattern page 3 onto foundation piecing paper once. If making more than one, print the pattern on page 4 instead.

### STEP 2 - CUT FABRIC

Refer to the table below for the size and quantity of pieces to cut. Quantities and sizes shown are for a single 3 inch block and are given as width x height.

**TIP** - If you want to make a larger block or project, print pattern page 4 according to the table on page two.

### STEP 3 - TIME TO SEW

Stitch the fabric parts to the pattern in numerical order.

### STEP 4 - TRIM

Trim excess fabric down to the edge of the solid perimeter.

If you would like to make more than one block, use the table below to calculate the number of 3 inch block you will need to make for your project.

| Finished Project Size<br>(No Sash or Border) | No. of 3 Inch Blocks Required | Pattern Pages To Print |
|----------------------------------------------|-------------------------------|------------------------|
| 6 Inch Block                                 | 4                             | 1                      |
| 9 Inch Block                                 | 9                             | 3                      |
| 12 Inch Block                                | 16                            | 4                      |
| 36 Inch Square Quilt                         | 144                           | 36                     |
| 48 Inch Square Quilt                         | 256                           | 64                     |
| 60 Inch Square Quilt                         | 400                           | 100                    |
| 72 Inch Square Quilt                         | 576                           | 144                    |
| 84 Inch Square Quilt                         | 784                           | 196                    |
| 96 Inch Square Quilt                         | 1,024                         | 256                    |
| 108 Inch Square Quilt                        | 1,296                         | 324                    |
